WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lon A. Stansbery and Myrtle C. Stansbery
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and fifty (\$650), DOLLARS,
To them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Margaret Scott and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot numbered two (2) in block numbered two (2) in
the Stansbery addition to Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded
plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Margaret Scott and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging

And hereby covenant with said Margaret Scott that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle C. Stansbery, wife of the said Lon A. Stansbery for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Margaret Scott all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
