WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we H. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid by L. H. Singleton, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said L. H. Singleton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot five 15th block two (2) in George C. Bryan's Addition to the city of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. H. Singleton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. H. Singleton that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell wife of the said H. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. H. Singleton all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
