WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, The Cherokee Company, and a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS, in hand paid by Olin P. Lewis and wife Lewis, in trust of the sum being handed acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Olin P. Lewis and wife, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the County of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north west quarter of the south east quarter of section thirty-three (33) township twenty-two west Range fourteenth east containing 40 acres more or less as the case may be, and also the west 10.27 acres of lot 4 of section 4 township nineteen (19) north Range 14 east.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Olin P. Lewis and wife, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Olin P. Lewis and wife, that will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, , wife of the said , for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
