# WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we A. N. Williams and Bessie L. Williams  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen \$50.00 DOLLARS,  
to us paid by Jas. F. Gilleland

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Jas. F. Gilleland and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
7 1/2 Acres of the N. 1/4 of the West half of Section 18, T. 2 N., R. 2 E.,  
lands lying in the Range 14 E. Creek, Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lot 15 in eight Block 2 in Township 26 N. Range 14 E. Creek, Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Jas. F. Gilleland and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jas. F. Gilleland that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said A. N. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jas. F. Gilleland all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
