WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we C. B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe and E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Fifty (350.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mate F. Snyder and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

S. 17 (17) Block seven (7) Lynch and
Forsythe's Addition to Tulsa Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mate F. Snyder and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mate F. Snyder that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

It being agreed by Mate F. Snyder, in the acceptance of this deed that there
is to be no drilling for oil or gas on above lot.
And I, E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe wife of the said C. B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mate F. Snyder all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
