**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Alex. S. Lewis and Elizabeth P. Lewis  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand five hundred DOLLARS,  
Cash in hand paid by The Cherokee Company, receipt of the  
same being hereby acknowledged. do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said The Cherokee Company and unto its successors  
lands lying in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory; to-wit:

The east one-half of the south west quarter of the north west  
quarter, and the south east quarter of the north west quarter  
of the north west quarter, and the north one-half of the north west  
quarter of the north west quarter of section twenty-six (26)  
Township twenty (20) North Range thirteen (13) east.  
Being 50 acres more or less as the case may be.

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Cherokee Company and unto its successors  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said The Cherokee Company that they will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elizabeth P. Lewis, wife of the said Alex. S. Lewis for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said The Cherokee Company and unto its successors all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
