WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Emily M. Campbell and Widow and sole Legatee
of W. C. Campbell, deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred & fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by C. O. Fryer receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said C. O. Fryer and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Two (2), Block Three (3), in George B. Perryman
addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to
the recorded plat thereof. This deed given to correct description
in deed given by W. C. Campbell & Emily M. Campbell her wife, issue of 1897
and recorded in Record 15 Page 33 on Oct 5 1907 in office of U. S. Clerk &
Co. Office Recorder in Tulsa Ind. Ter. covering same property.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. O. Fryer and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. O. Fryer that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said C. O. Fryer for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. O. Fryer all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
