WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we C. O. Frye and Vandella Frye
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty (750.00) DOLLARS,
In hand paid of which the receipt hereof is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said C. S. Turner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the George B. Perryman addition to Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot number two (2) in block three (3) in George
B. Perryman addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. S. Turner and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. S. Turner that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Vandella Frye, wife of the said C. O. Frye for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. S. Turner all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
