WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we C. O. Wallatt and Amanda Wallatt
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary J. Smith and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Stansbury Addition to Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number eleven (11) in Block number five (5)
in the Stansbury addition to the City of Tulsa,
Indian Territory according to the official plat
thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary J. Smith and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary J. Smith that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Amanda Wallatt, wife of the said C. O. Wallatt for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary J. Smith all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
