WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. M. Gilllette, Minnie M. Gilllette, J. M. Hall, Jennie L. Hall, J. W. Hocker
Carrie E. Hocker
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$ 775.00 DOLLARS,
 To us in hand paid by E. C. Mount the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said E. C. Mount and unto him heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Western District Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) and seven (7) Block numbered six (6) in the
Gilllette Hall addition to the City of Tulsa, according to the
plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. C. Mount and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. C. Mount that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. except one oil and gas lease held by Grant L.
Stebbins or his assigns.

And I, Minnie M. Gilllette wife of the said J. M. Gilllette and Jennie L. Hall wife of said
J. M. Hall and Carrie E. Hocker wife of said J. W. Hocker for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. C. Mount all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
