KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, The Cherokee Company, and a Corporation of Tulsa, Okla.,
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,
Cash in Land paid by Henry T. Jones and Martha Alice Jones,
Jones receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto Henry T. Jones & Martha Alice Jones and unto Theirs heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the County of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: and State of Oklahoma
and described more particularly as follows: The east one-half of the
North East Quarter of Northwest Quarter, and South half of south
West Quarter of Northeast Quarter, of Section 17, Township 20 North,
Range Thirteen (13) East.

Containing 40 acres more or less as the case may be.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry T. Jones & Martha Alice Jones and unto Theirs heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry T. Jones & Martha Alice Jones that it will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said Henry T. Jones & Martha Alice Jones, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry T. Jones & Martha Alice Jones all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
