WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Alice Tutrell and Frank Tutrell her husband his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$14,750 DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto John Martin and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property and situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, District of the , to wit: more particularly described as follows: to wit. The east half of the North west ten acres of Lot three in Section three, Township nineteen North, Range twelve east

To have and to hold the same unto the said John Martin and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging, the said Alice Tutrell and Frank Tutrell her husband his wife, are lawfully seized of said property, And hereby covenant with said John Martin that they will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever, except an oil and gas lease dated December 5th 1903, and filed for record February 15th, 1904 and recorded in Book 12, page 381 in Tulsa Oklahoma wherein Chisso Children appears as and , wife of the said Lessor and James H. Jones as lessee, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
