WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Forest R. Turner and Ethel Turner
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred & 00/100 DOLLARS,
 paid by Anna Godwin and Bedford Godwin the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Anna Godwin and Bedford Godwin
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot five (5) in Block two (2) Hodge addition
to Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said Anna Godwin and Bedford Godwin
 and unto their heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Anna Godwin and Bedford Godwin
 that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ethel Godwin, wife of the said Forest R. Turner
 for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Anna Godwin and Bedford Godwin
 all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
