WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we F. Mauchly, M.T. Self and M. J. Mauchly, Eliza Self
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of forty two 42 DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid by C. M. Green and J. J. Green of Higher Land for
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said C. M. Green & J. J. Green and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Black Water Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot No. six (6) in Block No. eight Townsite of Elmerford
Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. M. Green & J. J. Green and unto their heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. M. Green and J. J. Green that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. except and oil and gas lease now outstanding
against said land

And we F. Mauchly & Eliza Self wife of the said F. Mauchly & M.T. Self for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. M. Green & J. J. Green all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
