## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we F. Marchle, 2015 Self and M. Marchle, his wife  
 his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty five DOLLARS,  
cash in hand paid by J.M. Huston of Glenpool Ind. Ter  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J.M. Huston and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Black Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lot No twenty-two (22) and twenty three (23) in Block No.  
seven (7) and lot No four (4) in Block No six (6) town 10 N  
of Glenpool, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J.M. Huston and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J.M. Huston that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever, except any and all gas lease now outstanding  
against said land.

And M. J. Marchle, 2015 Self, wife of the said F. Marchle, 2015 Self for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J.M. Huston all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
