WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Ella P. Ray receipt of which is
herby acknowledged and confirmed. do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Ella P. Ray and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot seven (7) Block one (1) in Large Piquette Addition
to City of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the recorded
plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ella P. Ray and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella P. Ray that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said W. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ella P. Ray all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
