WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we S. T. Kelly wife of and Lin at law of Kelly do hereby
 for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) DOLLARS,
 to us paid by J. W. Bryant

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J. W. Bryant and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Fourth (4) Range Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all my undivided interest in and to the west half (1/2)
of the southeast quarter (1/4) of section five (5) township
twenty-one (21) north, range fourteen (14) east of the
Indian Meridian and containing eight (8) acres
more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. W. Bryant and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. W. Bryant that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, S. T. Kelly, wife of the said and Lin at law of Kelly for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. W. Bryant all right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
