WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER. and homestead

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

 to her in hand paid,

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said William Cook, formerly William Scott and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described  
 lands lying in the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The E 1/2 of the N 1/2 of the S 1/2 and the N 1/2 of the S 1/2 of the S 1/2, all in  
section nine (9) township 22 north, range fourteen (14) east of the  
Indian Meridian, containing thirty acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said William Cook and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William Cook and his heirs and assigns, that I am  
 completely released of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance; that I  
 have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and I do  
 hereby warrant and defend the title to said premises against the lawful  
 claims of all persons  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William Cook all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said premises.
