WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell; his wife
and W. P. Moore and Anna E. Moore
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-two 50.00 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by H. B. Cunn, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said H. B. Cunn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the more addition to West Tulsa, Creek Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot numbered nine (9) in block numbered
thirty (3) situated in more addition to West Tulsa, Creek
Native Indian Territory, according to the recorded
plat filed there.

To have and to hold the same unto the said H. B. Cunn and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. B. Cunn that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
and Anna E. Moore, wife of the said W. P. Moore
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said James P. Gough all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
