WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we L. K. Cone and Edith M. Cone
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said The Prudential Investment Company and unto its heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the south fifteen (15) feet of Lot nineteen (19)
and all of Lots twenty (20) and twenty-one
(21) in the Bayne addition to Tulsa Indian
Territory according to the official plat thereon

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Prudential Investment Company and unto its heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said The Prudential Investment Company that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Edith M. Cone, wife of the said L. K. Cone for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said The Prudential Investment Company all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
