WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we S. L. Davis and Addie Davis husband and wife, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and forty acres of land in DOLLARS, Newton County, Mo., the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid by D. D. Horn of Missouri, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said D. D. Horn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) and the north twenty one feet (21) of lot five (5) Block
sixty four (64), and according to the official plat, and Government survey
of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

Subject to a loan with the Farmers and Home Savings and Loan
Association of Nevada, Mo., for \$500 and \$600, and interest

To have and to hold the same unto the said D. D. Horn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said D. D. Horn that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Addie Davis, wife of the said S. L. Davis for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said D. D. Horn all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
