WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Loisella Perryman and John F. Perryman
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand & no DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by S. W. Marr

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said S. W. Marr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south west quarter of the north west
quarter of Section eight (8) Township nineteen (19)
north and range fourteen (14) east consisting of
forty (40) acres.

To have and to hold the same unto the said S. W. Marr and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said S. W. Marr that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, John F. Perryman husband of the said Loisella Perryman for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said S. W. Marr all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
