WARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we *Thomas W. Lowe* and "*single*"  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *one hundred & fifty* *no. 100* DOLLARS,  
*the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged & to us in*  
*hand paid by Robert & George Rogers* do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said *Robert & George Rogers* and unto *their* heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the *Turkey Addition to Tulsa* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
*Lot five (5) Block four (4) in the Turkey Addition to Tulsa*  
*Ind. Ter. and according to the recorded plat of said*  
*addition, size 60 x 115 feet.*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *Robert & George Rogers* and unto *their* heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Robert & George Rogers* that *he* will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *Thomas W. Lowe*, wife of the said *Robert & George Rogers* for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Robert & George Rogers* all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
