WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. H. Ungles and Lurena Ungles
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred seventy five DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by Mary Cushman the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary Cushman and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered two (2) in Block number eight (8) in the
town of Turkey, Indian Territory as shown by the
plat of said town.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary Cushman and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Mary Cushman that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lurena Ungles, wife of the said J. H. Ungles for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary Cushman all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
