WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we M.B. Shultz and Liddie M. Shultz
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred sixty six ^{no} 1166 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of same being hereby acknowledged and to us
 paid by S. F. Jones do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said S. F. Jones and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

An undivided "one sixth" (1/6) interest in and to the north
east 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of section twenty two (22)
township eighteen (18) N. range twelve (12) E.

To have and to hold the same unto the said S. F. Jones and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said S. F. Jones that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Liddie M. Shultz, wife of the said M.B. Shultz for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said S. F. Jones all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
