WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Edna Harris (nee Harris) and her husband Addie Harris deceased his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Carl C. Magee and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The southeast quarter (SW 1/4) of section three (3) Twp. 10 N. (15) north range thirteen (13) east

To have and to hold the same unto the said Carl C. Magee and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Carl C. Magee that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Edna Harris, wife of the said Carl C. Magee for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Carl C. Magee all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
