WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred, fifty-five DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by Sarah E. Whedbee, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Sarah E. Whedbee and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Town of West Tulsa Creek Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lots number seven (7) eight (8) and nine (9) in block number
seven (7), situate in West Tulsa Creek (Tulsa), Indian Territory, according
to the recorded plat filed thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Sarah E. Whedbee and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Sarah E. Whedbee that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Sarah E. Whedbee all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
