WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Herman Burger and Rose Burger
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred & 75/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by William Walker, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said William Walker and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot one (1) in Block one (1) Surveys addition to the Town of
Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said William Walker and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William Walker that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rose Burger, wife of the said Herman Burger for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William Walker all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
