WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Edmond Jackson and Emma G. Jackson  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & forty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Calvin M. Barnett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot (4) seven in block (37) thirty seven in the town of  
Red Fork Indian Territory, said lot being situated on Main  
Street in said town of Red Fork, Ind. Terr.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Calvin M. Barnett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Calvin M. Barnett that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emma G. Jackson, wife of the said Edmond Jackson for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Calvin M. Barnett all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
