WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. L. Hutchinson and Malissa Hutchinson
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said C. E. Strange and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Northern Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: and in the town
of Skiatook, town
lots number one, two, three and four (1, 2, 3, 4) in block
fifteen (15) according to the plat of the town of Skiatook

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. E. Strange and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. E. Strange that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. except for any inambrance taken, but not for
defect in government title previous to ceding and town

And I, Malissa Hutchinson, wife of the said J. L. Hutchinson for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. E. Strange all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
