WARRANTY DEED

~~WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.~~

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell

his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty-four hundred DOLLARS,
(\$8400.00) immediately paid by Plaintiff Sanders' Credit Company, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said Patacliff, Sanders Green Company and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all of lots forty, two (2) and three (3), and that part of lot No. one (1) in Section No. seventy-five (75) in the original town of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that is described as follows: Beginning at a point three and one-half (3 1/2) feet north of the southeast corner of lot No. one (1) and running northwesterly direction on a diagonal line to a point eleven (11) feet north of the southline of lot No. one (1) and fifty (50) feet from the eastline of said lot No. one (1), thence running in a northerly direction on a level parallel with the west line of said lot No. one (1) at distance of one (1) foot, thence running in a westerly direction a distance of fifty (50) feet to the ally limit through said block No. seventy-five (75), thence running along said ally line a distance of ten (10) feet to the southwest corner of said lot No. one (1), thence running in an easterly direction a distance of one hundred and forty (140) feet along said lot line to the southeast corner of said lot No. one (1) thence running in a northerly direction along the east line of said lot No. one (1) a distance of three and one-half (3 1/2) feet to the place of beginning, the above being a plot of ground having a frontage of 123 1/2 feet on said ally and a depth of 140 feet in fact, first, last and throughout of 33 feet in the side to the south and width of 33 feet in the side to the north, to have and to hold the same unto the said Ratcliff - Sanders General Company and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ratcliff-Sanders Lencer Company that ~~said~~ will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever, except the passing taxes. This deed is given to correct a deed, dated June 20th, 1870, executed by John O. Mitchell and wife Alice M. Ratcliff, conveying the above described land to the Sanders Lencer Company. In said deed the grantee is named as the Ratcliff Lencer Company. And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1000, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ratcliff-Sanders Lencer Company all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
