WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we B. H. Sands and Ethel M. Sands
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said C. C. Weibling and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot number seven (7) in block number
three (3) in Oakdale Suburb of the Town of Tulsa
Creek Nation Indian Territory, according to the
official survey and recorded plat Twenty

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. C. Weibling and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. C. Weibling that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ethel M. Sands, wife of the said B. H. Sands for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. C. Weibling all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
