WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we St. Williams and Bessie L. Williams
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred DOLLARS,
to us paid by Lora Disney
do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Lora Disney and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
NE 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 and the West half (shown on the W.D. Survey as lots
1 & 2) of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec 3, T. 9 N. and Range 14 E, Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot 22 No Twenty Two Block 2, No. Twenty One in Valley
22.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Lora Disney and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lora Disney that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said St. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lora Disney all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
