WARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Maurice A. D. Vinna and Ella M. D. Vinna  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,  
Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Rachel C. Brady and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot one (1) & two (2) in Block Six (6) in Brady Heights addition  
to the City of Tulsa according to recorded plat thereof  
Except the Government Appraised thereon

To have and to hold the same unto the said Rachel C. Brady and unto her heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rachel C. Brady that we will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ella M. D. Vinna, wife of the said Maurice A. D. Vinna for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rachel C. Brady all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
