WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred seventy no. 00 DOLLARS,
ten in hand paid by J. P. Bliss, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged. do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. P. Bliss and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the County of Creek, Indian Territory Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of lots numbered thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) in Block number
fifteen (15) situated in West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory
according to the recorded plat filed thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. P. Bliss and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant not with said J. P. Bliss that she will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. P. Bliss all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
