WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J.D. Hagler and Margaret Hagler
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred fifty (\$850.00) DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid, by John B. Youngblood, the receipt whereof
is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John B. Youngblood and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered nine (9) in Block numbered two of the
Old Addition to Tulsa according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said John B. Youngblood and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John B. Youngblood that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret Hagler, wife of the said J.D. Hagler for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John B. Youngblood all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
