**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John A. Mitchell & Alice M. Mitchell his wife and W. P. Moore & Anna E. Moore  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by W. C. Simpson, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. C. Simpson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the more addition to west Tulsa Creek National Indian Territory, to-wit:  
All of lot numbered one (1) in block numbered seven (7) situate  
in more addition to west Tulsa Creek National Indian Territory  
according to the recorded plat filed thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. C. Simpson and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. C. Simpson that we will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John A. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
and Anna E. Moore wife of the said W. P. Moore money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. C. Simpson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
