WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we *F. Marchle & M. T. Self* his wife, and *M. T. Self & Eliza Self*, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *forty two + 75.00 (\$42.75)* DOLLARS, cash in hand paid by *Sarah A. Chambers of Mound, S. T.* the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said *Sarah A. Chambers* and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Creek* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: *Lot no fourteen (14) in Block no seven (7) Town of Okmuntal, Ind. Ter.*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *Sarah A. Chambers* and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Sarah A. Chambers* that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever, except oil and gas lease info outstanding against said land.

And we, *M. J. Marchle & Eliza Self*, wife of the said *F. Marchle & M. T. Self* for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Sarah A. Chambers* all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
