WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Aaron Hagaman and Jessima Hagaman
of Lawton, Okla. formerly Ind. Terr.
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (\$800.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W.E. Trower and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Western District Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot one (1) in block (3) three of the incorporated town of Lawton,
Okla. formerly Ind. Terr. according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W.E. Trower of Forest Grove, Ark. and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W.E. Trower that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jessima Hagaman, wife of the said Aaron Hagaman for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W.E. Trower all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
