WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Hennietta R. Swope and G. H. Swope

 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty one hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John O. Mitchell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
South seventy five (75) feet Lot four (4)
Block one hundred forty seven (147) accord-
ing to the government survey and plat
of the town of Tulsa Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said John O. Mitchell and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John O. Mitchell that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, G. H. Swope ~~husband~~ Hennietta R. Swope for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John O. Mitchell all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
