**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we A. Charles W. Grimes and Angie  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Sixty DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by George Campbell  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said George Campbell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot thirteen (13) in block two (2) in Bellview Addition to Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said George Campbell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George Campbell that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Angie, wife of the said George Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George Campbell all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
