## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lila D. Lindsey and L. W. Lindsey, her husband  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred & fifty DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged in hand paid by  
P. C. Corlett to Lila D. Lindsey do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said P. C. Corlett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The one town lot numbered five (5) in the block numbered eleven  
(11) located in the second Lindsey addition to Tulsa as per  
plat thereof executed by J. C. Patton

To have and to hold the same unto the said P. C. Corlett and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said P. C. Corlett that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey, husband, of the said Lila D. Lindsey, for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said P. C. Corlett all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
