## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Oscar H. Eysenbach and Bessie C. Eysenbach  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four thousand two hundred DOLLARS,  
The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Robert Oglesby and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot no. 61 six Block (150) one hundred & fifty in the incorporated  
town of Tulsa I.T. according to the official plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Robert Oglesby and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert Oglesby that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

Except a certain mortgage of \$15.00 dated Feb 11, 1907

And I, Bessie C. Eysenbach, wife of the said Oscar H. Eysenbach for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert Oglesby all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
