WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we D.W. Crouch and Alice Crouch
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said Ara Bella McKeever and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Second Lindsey Addition to Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number two (2) in Block number nine (9) in
the Second Lindsey Addition to Tulsa Indian Territory
according to the record and plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ara Bella McKeever and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ara Bella McKeever that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice Crouch, wife of the said D.W. Crouch for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ara Bella McKeever all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
