WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPALED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O Mitchell & Alice M Mitchell his wife Wesley P Moore & Anna E Moore
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of sixty two & 57/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Charles Edwards the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Charles Edwards and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block Three (3) Moore addition to
west Tulsa Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Charles Edwards and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charles Edwards that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M Mitchell, wife of the said John O Mitchell and Anna E Moore wife of the said Wesley P Moore
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Charles Edwards all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
