WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we H. F. Newblock and Addie Newblock
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Several hundred fifty DOLLARS,
ten in hand paid, by Bernard Hirschy, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Bernard Hirschy and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek National Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The south half of lot two (2) in block one hundred sixty six (166) in the
town of Tulsa, according to the official survey

To have and to hold the same unto the said Bernard Hirschy and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Bernard Hirschy that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Addie Newblock, wife of the said H. F. Newblock for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Bernard Hirschy all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
