WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPALED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we L. O. Brintnall and Bettie L. Brintnall
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty DOLLARS,
to them paid cash in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged as
paid by M. T. Bowen do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said M. T. Bowen and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Tulsa County Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot twenty (20) in block thirty eight (38) in the town of Skiatook
Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof.

[To have and to hold the same unto the said M. T. Bowen and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.]

And hereby covenant with said M. T. Bowen that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bettie L. Brintnall, wife of the said L. O. Brintnall for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M. T. Bowen my all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
