WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lila D. Lindsey and L. W. Lindsey her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by T. L. Robinson to Lila D. Lindsey
 and L. W. Lindsey the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said T. L. Robinson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Located in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec Eleven
 (11) Township nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East
 beginning sixty (60) feet South of the S.E. corner
 of Block 10 of the same north 100 feet East
 1810 feet to place of beginning

To have and to hold the same unto the said T. L. Robinson and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. L. Robinson that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband of the said Lila D. Lindsey and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said T. L. Robinson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
