WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. B. Chambers and Callie Chambers
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy two and 50/100 (\$72.50) DOLLARS,
to use in land paid by A. R. Evans, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said A. R. Evans and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot seventeen (17) in block fifteen (15) in the town of West Tulsa
 Creek Nation, Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said A. R. Evans and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. R. Evans that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Callie Chambers, wife of the said J. B. Chambers for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. R. Evans all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
