WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Sophia Daniel and John H. Daniel her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred DOLLARS,
 to them paid cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said James Perrier and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation, Northern Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot nine (9) and ten (10) in Block forty (40) in the town of Skatook Indian
Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said James Perrier and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said James Perrier that and will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, John H. Daniel husband, wife of the said Sophia Daniel for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said James Perrier all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
